CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE TEACHERS:

4. You are responsible to train your junior colleagues.
5. Open confrontation of whatever nature must be avoided
6. Keep all teaching schedules updated.
7. All correspondence should be channelized through the principal
8. Treat your colleagues with courtesy at all times.
9. Be impartial in your decisions pertaining to the students and staff
10. Do not discriminate on grounds of race, colour or creed.
11. Be regular and punctual the teachers should report for duty atleast.
12. 15minutes before the teaching session begins.
13. Prior approval in writing should be obtained before proceeding on leave, in case of emergency inform your HOD without undue delay.
